Rocketry

This will be an introductory rocketry class. We will be learning about basic rocketry concepts and applying them to building and launching air powered rockets that have the ability to fly several hundred feet into the air and leave the launcher at speeds approaching 200 miles per hour. No prior knowledge is necessary for enjoying this course.

Hiking and Biking **NEW**

In this class we will explore both the awesome hiking and biking trails in St. Croix Falls! Students will need to bring their bike to school for the week, as most days we will do a combination of hiking and biking, with a break in the middle. SAFETY COURSES GRADES 3-8

Boater Safety

Wisconsin boating safety certification or out-of-state equivalent certification is required for operators born on or after Jan. 1, 1989. Anyone is eligible to take the class and receive a safety education completion certificate, however, courses are designed at a 5th-grade level or up. All students should bring their DNR number to class.

Cost: \$10 Week 1

ATV/Snowmobile Safety

Instruction emphasizes laws and regulations, ethics, personal safety and the proper use of all-terrain vehicles and snowmobiles. Students may take this course before their 12th birthday, but safety certification will not become valid until their birthdate. Students should bring their DNR number to class with them.

Cost: \$10 per certification (\$20 for both) Weeks 2 and 3

Hunter's Safety

*Must be at least 10 years old by December 31 to enroll, strongly recommended for students grade 6 and up as the written test is designed for ages 12+. Class size is limited to 12 per week.

Wisconsin DNR offers safety courses for students aged 10+ years old. In its age-old history, the hunting tradition in this state is strong. This course will focus on the traditions of safe hunting so long enjoyed by many generations. Students should bring their DNR number with them to

The Osceola Aquatic Center reserves the right to place students with other swimmers with like skills

Level 1: Intro to Water Skills (all with assistance)

- ▼Fully submerge face for 3 seconds

- 🛚 *Combined arm & leg action front back
- ▼Front and back glides

Level 2: Fundamental Aquatic Skills (all independently)

- ▼Fully submerge head for 5 seconds
- ▼Float on front unsupported 10 seconds

- ▼Front crawl 5 body lengths/20 feet w/ rotary breathing 5 times

- ⊠*Bob 5 times
- ▼Flutter kick on front and back

Level 3: Stroke Development

- ▼Front and back glide with flutter & dolphin kick
 - *Swim front crawl with rotary breathing 25 yards
- ⊠*Swim back crawl 15 yards
- **⊠*Tread water 1 minute.**
- *Dive from side of pool from kneeling & compact positions
- ▼Required exit skills using all skills above

Level 4: Stroke Improvement

- ⊠ *Elementary backstroke 25 yards
- **⊠** *Breaststroke 15 yards
- **⊠** *Tread water 2 minutes
- - *Front crawl 25 yards with rotary breathing
- ⊠*Back crawl 15 vards

- **⊠***Breaststroke 15 yards

Level 5: Stroke Refinement

- **X** *Long shallow dive

- ⊠*Front crawl 50 yards

- **⊠***Butterfly 25 yards

- ⊠ *Sculling 30 seconds

Level 6: Advanced Personal Water Safety

- ▼Front crawl 100 yards

- **⊠***Butterfly 50 yards
- 🛮 *Dive to a depth of 7-10 feet and retrieve object


