20 Hours Required

DEFINITION: The service project should involve something out of the ordinary. Regular volunteer work such as candy striping or Sunday School Teaching does not qualify, nor does work at home which is ordinarily done/required. Projects might include yard or home repair work for senior citizens or disabled persons; unpaid baby-sitting or other childcare; unpaid tutoring; special (one-time) home, school, or community activities; special church activities, etc. The project(s) should be the equivalent of several days' work in time and/or effort. Two or three NHS members may work on the same project if it is unusually demanding.
