Dear St. Croix Falls High School parents and students,

Beginning on Dec. 14, students in grades 5-12 will be engaged in learning partially in school and partially online. This hybrid model will break students into two groups alphabetically. Group A--students whose last names begin with the letters A through K--will be attending school in person on Monday, Wednesday and alternating Fridays. Group A students will attend all classes virtually on Tuesdays, Thursdays and alternating Fridays. Group B--students whose last names begin with the letters L through Z--will be attending school in person on Tuesdays, Thursdays and alternating Fridays attend classes virtually on Mondays, Wednesdays and alternating Fridays. Students from the same family with last names in both groups A and B will be following the group B schedule. This hybrid schedule allows students in the upper grades to attend classes while improving social distancing in all areas of the school. The board adopted this model for the period of Dec. 14-Dec. 22.
