

Dear Students/Parents,

Effective Monday, December 14 through Tuesday, December 22 grades 5-12 will be switching to a hybrid model of delivery for students. The hybrid learning model in grades 5-12 consists of students with last names beginning with A-K attending school in person M,W, every other F. and virtually when not at school. Students with last names beginning L-Z attend in person T,Th every other F and virtually when not in school. When students attend virtually, they google meet at their normally scheduled class time via google meets and use schoology to complete assignments. Teachers will have google meet sessions set up in schoology for your child to attend at their normal class time. Your child's attendance will be recorded as they log into the google meet for tracking purposes. If your child is too sick, has a planned vacation or other pre-excused absence, please contact Christie Kelly or Christina White via email to be excused from the online class for that time.
