TROLL'S STUDENT PROGRAM

This Troll-Certified Program gives students the opportunity to have fun, enjoy winter, & learn to safely ski and snowboard. Students are invited to join us on the slopes once a week throughout the season with their school.

PROGRAM SCHEDULE

This program begins the week of Dec. 4, 2023, valid **3:00pm - Close** (conditions permitting) to the end of the season. Students can ski and/or snowboard during the specified time your school chooses to designate on your pass.

You may hit the slopes during winter break & on holidays after 3PM, during the time your pass is valid. Special discounts are also available if you're a passholder.



YOUR RESPONSIBILITY CODE

1. Always stay in control. You must be able to stop or avoid people or objects.
2. People ahead or downhill of you have the right-of-way. You must avoid them.
3. Stop only where you are visible from above and do not restrict traffic.
4. Look uphill and avoid others before starting downhill or entering a trail.
5. You must prevent runaway equipment.
6. Read and obey all signs, warnings, and hazard markings.
7. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
8. You must know how and be able to load, ride and unload lifts safely. If you need assistance, ask the lift attendant.
9. Do not use lifts or terrain when impaired by alcohol or drugs.
10. If you are involved in a collision or incident, share your contact information with each other and a ski area employee.

TROLLHAUGEN RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Never ski in the woods or off the marked trails
2. Remain in control at all times.
3. **DO NOT** build jumps on the runs
4. Be aware of those around you, especially the smaller ones & the beginner skiers/ snowboarders
5. Foul language and disorderly conduct has no place on the hills of Trollhaugen.
6. No alcohol on the slopes. No drugs.
7. Passes are non-transferable.

This is a partial list of the problems we prefer not to encounter at our Area. Please respect and obey our rules. Failure to adhere to these rules will result in your pass being pulled.

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**TROLLHAUGEN SEASON PASS RELEASE OF LIABILITY
FOR THE 2023-2024 SKI SEASON**

**PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING.
THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER OF CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS.**

I understand that skiing in its various forms, including snowboarding, involves risks, dangers, and hazards that may cause serious personal injury or death and that injuries are a common and ordinary occurrence. Risks include, but are not limited to, changes in terrain, weather and snow surfaces, ice, moguls, bare spots, rocks, stumps, debris, fences, posts, trees, lift equipment and towers, surface lifts, light poles, signs, buildings, roads and walkways, ramps, table tops and other jumps, including the angle of their approaches and the angle and length of their take-off ramps and landing areas, rails, boxes, and all other terrain features, padded and non-padded obstacles, snowmaking and grooming operations and equipment, snowmobile operations, and collisions with other persons and other natural and man-made hazards. I acknowledge that the risks in the sport of skiing can be greatly reduced by taking lessons, abiding by the Skier Responsibility code (known as Your Responsibility Code), and using common sense.

In consideration of the purchase of a season pass for the 2023/2024 ski seasons for Trollhaugen and use of its facilities, **I RELEASE AND FULLY DISCHARGE Trollhaugen, its owners, officers, shareholders, agents, and employees (collectively "TROLLHAUGEN RELEASEES") from any liability resulting from any personal injury to myself, including death, or damage to my property which is caused by the BREACH OF ANY EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTY or the NEGLIGENT ACT OR OMISSION of any TROLLHAUGEN RELEASEE in the design, location, construction, inspection, maintenance, and repair of the conditions on or about the premises or ski area or the operations of the ski area, including:**

- the design, location, construction, inspection, maintenance, and repair of trails, ski runs, and slopes, including their grooming and modifications to their natural steepness and pitches;
- the design, location, construction, inspection, and maintenance of table tops and other jumps, including the angle of their approaches and the angle and length of the take-off ramps and landing areas;
- the design, location, construction, inspection, and maintenance of all other terrain features, including rails, boxes, and tube jams;
- grooming, snow-making, and snowmobile operations, the operation of chairlifts and conveyor and handle tows, and chairlift and conveyor and handle tow loading and unloading operations, including the failure to rescue an unseated passenger;
- the padding or non-padding of natural and man-made obstacles and hazards;
- the posting or failure to post warnings and signs, and the construction of or non-construction of fences or other barriers, including the selection of the construction materials; and
- the classification and labeling of trails, ski runs, and terrain features.

In accordance with Wisconsin law, nothing in this Release should be construed as releasing, discharging, or waiving any claims I may have for reckless or intentional acts on the part of any TROLLHAUGEN RELEASEE.

In the event I am signing as a parent/guardian of a minor, I represent I have full authority to do so, realizing this Release is binding upon the minor as well as myself.

I understand that, for a fee of \$100.00 in addition to the normal season pass price, Trollhaugen offers an optional season pass that does not require me to sign a Release of Liability. In signing this Release of Liability, I acknowledge I am aware of this option offered by Trollhaugen and hereby waive my right to purchase the same.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND UNDERSTAND ITS CONTENTS. I AM AWARE BY AGREEING TO THIS RELEASE OF LIABILITY, I AM WAIVING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE TROLLHAUGEN, ITS OWNERS, OFFICERS, SHAREHOLDERS, AGENTS, OR EMPLOYEES FOR CERTAIN CLAIMS.
